1	Boys	
Lads, you'll get to hear some cracking stories about how God transforms lives. You'll get to hear and talk about the things that boys do and experience. We'll open the bible, look at some examples and see if we can find the best way to live. <i>Disclaimer. There may be talk of football and bottom noises.</i>		
2	Girls	
Whether shoes, power drills, football, Lego, dancing or shopping are the things that fascinate you the most, we'll be looking at how life can look for girls in the 21 <sup>st</sup> century. We will look at what the bible says and some role models who can point us in the right direction.		
3	Faith in the Family	
Sometimes families can be the most awkward places in the world, where saying anything at all can cause a riot. But they also can be places of love and fun. Whatever your family looks like, we will look at ways that we can be the people of God where we spend most of our time.		
4	Challenging Churches	
The church was never set up to be dull, boring and fusty. Neither was it set up to be an explosion of noise and flashing lights. You may well find that your church sits in the middle. Whatever your church looks like, the question has to be asked what is the church for and how it is doing?		
5	Healthy Heads	
What do you do when you're angry? Okay, now what about when you're upset? Or thrilled? Excited? Lonely? Believe it or not, the bible is chock-full of stories about people experiencing all of these things. We'll be looking at some of these stories and finding out how we can learn to express ourselves to those around us, and to God, no matter what we're feeling.		
6	Justice/ Going Global	
If we really are Family, then we need to be Family wherever we are. That may mean looking after the very people who need help the most. We will be learning about children from different cultures to our own and how we can be Family. We will look at how and why we can welcome people from different countries or backgrounds.		
7	Practical Prayer	
This hands-on session will be an opportunity to look at some amazing ways that we can pray with and for people. We will look at the who, what, where, when and why. Come prepared to be challenged, amazed, excited and enthralled.		
8	Healthy Habits (Basics of Christianity)	
Prayer, bible study, worship and meeting together are the basics building blocks of being a Christian. We'll be looking at how each of these allows us to grow in our relationship with God and with other people. They say it takes three weeks to form a habit, so if you have a rattle at these, in 21 days time, you'll be a natural.		
9	Panel	
Under new management, the Panel is the perfect place where you can bring along any question that you've been wanting to ask, but have never had the chance to. Come expecting to meet new people and have your questions answered. Don't worry, you can write your questions down before hand.
